- 18 years of age or older
- High school diploma or high school equivalent
- Pass a drug screen this includes recreational and medical marijuana (remains in your system for 45+ days)
- Basic math and mechanical reasoning assessment
- · Federal or State Photo ID

Pre-registration opens on **June 10th**.

FCA Early Access Applications for Detroiters – late **August/September**

Over the next 18 months, FCA is planning on conducting interviews, making conditional offers and hiring new employees.

Jobs begin – late 2019 until late 2020.

Here are the steps to receive early access for Detroiters

STEP 1.

Starting on June 10th, complete the pre-registration questions at **detroitatwork.com/FCA** and sign up for a Detroit at Work FCA Job Readiness Event.

The pre-registration questions include your name, address, contact information, and FCA job requirement questions. Please answer all questions honestly.

There will be over 50 job readiness events at various dates, times and locations throughout the city of Detroit. **YOU MUST ATTEND** one of these events to be eligible for the early access application process.

You will receive an email confirmation when you pre-register and sign up for a prep event.

STEP 2.

Attend and complete the Job Readiness Event. At these events, Detroit at Work will provide both resources and support to help Detroiters become job ready.

Job Readiness Events will include:

- Assistance obtaining job-related documentation (such as photo ID)
- FCA application review assistance
- Math and mechanical reasoning practice tests and sign ups for on-going support
- Answers to any questions you have about job readiness or what's involved in the hiring process

STEP 3.

Complete any follow-up activities from the Event. This could include applying for social security card and qualifying ID, math testing support classes, and/or high school graduation or equivalent documentation.
