Description of Training Program:

This is a 2000-hour apprenticeship program. RTI curriculum provides a hands-on learning experience in a factory setting. Students will practice standard sewing techniques on a variety of industrial machines using multiple textiles. They will receive an overview of industrial manufacturing processes, technical terminology, materials knowledge, safety and employee responsibility. Upon completion, students will be eligible to apply for On-the-Job Training (OJT) at a (USDOL) approved apprenticeship site -Industrial Sewing Machine Operator.
