What are the program benefits?

- · One-on-one career and financial coaching
- Dedicated Employment Specialist who helps match participants to high-wage jobs
- Access to supportive services up to \$1K in value (clothing, driver's license, tools, etc.)
- Referrals to barrier resolution services including record expungement, mental health and substance use treatment, counseling, support negotiating tickets, child support, child care assistance, etc.
- · Referrals to high school equivalency (GED) programs; some with paid incentives

- Paid Internships with employer partners earning \$12 per hour while they gain work experience
- Funding of tuitions for selected training programs that offer industry recognized credentials
- Access to thousands of jobs through Career Center partners, including job matching and placement assistance
- Retention support and monthly follow-up to ensure employment is maintained

• Men or women, 18+ years on probation, parole, or released from any correctional facility (county, state, federal) within the past 24 months

- Reside in the City of Detroit or Wayne County address outside of Detroit
- Seeking any of the following: employment, GED credential, vocational training, transitional employment (paid internship), and/or financial counseling
