Description of Training Program:

(ITD) Within the IT Developer program, students will learn intermediate-level coding tasks in the Python language, including the ability to design, develop, debug, execute, and refactor multi-module Python programs, as well as measures their skills and knowledge related to analyzing and modeling real-life problems in OOP categories with the use of the fundamental notions and techniques available in the object-oriented approach. In Python Associate Programming students gain the ability to accomplish coding tasks related to the essentials of programming in the Python language. Learners will demonstrate sufficient knowledge of the universal concepts of computer programming, the syntax, and semantics of the Python language, as well as the skills in resolving typical implementation challenges with the help of the Python Standard Library to acquire the PCAP™ Certified Associate Python Programmer. Participants are trained in cohorts that generally run with approximately 15-20 seats. The program is delivered in 450-hours, 15-week total, earning additional stackable credentials.
