### Description of Training Program:

Our program will teach and train individuals in GED preparation to take and pass their GED test as well as basic skilled trades in carpentry, electrical, plumbing, drywall repair, and other building maintenance techniques. The skilled trades portion includes tool safety instruction which leads to an OSHA 10 certificate. Our program also includes CPR training, job training, and other wraparound services. Once participants complete our course, they will have credentials for workplace safety on a construction site or in any other work site. They will be in position to pass the GED Test.

They will have a resume and through our Job Training and Maintaining course, they will leave with skills that make them leaders in their fields as they will be equipped with interviewing skills, customer service skills, conflict resolution skills, social and emotional control, and many other skills that enhance their ability to take initiative and be a positive leader in the workforce.
