Carpenters are skilled in laying out, measuring, cutting, erecting, and joining materials together. They are highly trained to work quickly, accurately, and safely, while delivering the quality of work contractors and their customers have come to expect. Classroom instructional: 8 hours biweekly, 24 sessions per year (96 classroom session total), and 2000 OJT hours per year (4000 OJT hours total) over 4 year apprenticeship.
