Description of Training Program:

(ITP) Within the IT Pathways program, students earn industry certifications through mastery-based learning and training. At the start of each program, students attend orientation, obtain the Workforce Development policies and procedures, receive any additional support determined by a needs assessment and resources required for training. Throughout the training cycle, students acquire industry related knowledge through classroom lectures, hands-on experience and projects that were developed in conjunction with third-party curriculum vendors and industry/employer partners. Participants are trained in cohorts that generally run with approximately 25-30 seats. The program is delivered in three, 150-hour, 5-week, modules to advanced training competencies to earn additional stackable credentials.
