Logistics & Transportation Program (Parts A & B)

Part A focuses on foundational skills including forklift operation (with certification), computer and financial literacy, customer service, teamwork, and critical thinking. Students also receive career preparation through resume development, job readiness training, and industry research.

Part B builds on this foundation with business-focused topics such as communication, supply chain management, managerial accounting, and entrepreneurship. Students also benefit from leadership training and insights from professional guest speakers. Upon completion, participants are well-prepared for a range of roles in the logistics and transportation sector or to pursue entrepreneurial ventures.
