Description of Training Program:

Nurse Aide Training focuses on helping individuals improve themselves by empowering students with a skill trade. We offer Nurse Aide Training to students that will become Certified Nursing Assistant after successfully passing that state exam. Students will complete our 4-week hybrid training course with training in Basic Life Support and professional development. We offer an additional 4 hours to utilize our lab area to practice for state exam. This must be used within one week after completion of the program. Students will be prepared to enter the workforce with TWO certifications, professional development skills and endless opportunities as a CNA.

The CNA and Basic Life Support training is 3-weeks with the final week focused on state testing, professional development and job placement assistance.

Due to the nature of the teaching students are required to adhere to our attendance policy.

Students are allowed a ONE-TIME re-entry within 30 days of original start date, if approved by Administrator/Program Coordinator and according to our Make Up Day Policy. If re-entry exceeds past 30 days, then the student must re-apply for the program and pay tuition rate.
