Marosa's Phlebotomy Technician program prepares students for entry-level roles as phlebotomy technicians, lab assistants, and specimen processors. Over 10 weeks, students attend class two weekdays per week (3 hours per day) plus a weekly Saturday session, and train hands-on with different needle sizes and gauges and instruments used in blood testing to build core venipuncture and specimen-handling skills.
