WorkKeys is a skills assessment tool that helps SER and employers assess skills, select, hire, train, and develop a high quality workforce. The BCO program participants receive academic instruction and work readiness training and attain the industry-recognized credentials necessary to enter directly into career pathways within the construction industry or to apply for entry into apprenticeship opportunities with extensive network of labor partners.
